Topic: Arrest of Aggravated Kidnapping Suspect

The suspect in the aggravated assault on a public servant and aggravated kidnapping with a deadly weapon which occurred on May 20, 2014 has been apprehended. The original incident involved a stolen vehicle in Hurst and a foot pursuit ending in the 7400 block of Bridges Avenue in Richland Hills. The suspect was apprehended today in Texarkana, Arkansas by members of the Texarkana Police Department with the assistance of the U.S. Marshals North Texas Fugitive Task Force.

The investigation led to the identification of the suspect as Eric Joseph Phillips, a 36 year-old white male. The Hurst Police Department requested the assistance of the U.S. Marshals North Texas Fugitive Task Force after warrants were obtained for Phillips.
