Topic: Child Pornography Arrests

During the week of November 17, 2014, Detectives from the Hurst Police Department began an investigation from a tip received from The National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, regarding child pornography. Operating on the tip, Detectives obtained a search warrant for a home in Fort Worth, which lead to a seizure of a large amount of evidence of child pornography and exploitation of children.

Detectives were able to arrest Randy Ray Wesson, w/m, 28 years of age on charges of Possession with intent to Promote Child Pornography, Sale/Display of Harmful Material, Tampering with Governmental Record, with the bond on combined charges set at \$3,000,000. Also arrested was Ricardo Javid Lugo, w/m, 17 years of age, on Possession of Child Pornography, bond set at \$250,000.

The investigation has revealed that Ricardo Lugo was enrolled in the HEB Independent School District as a 12 year old in the 6th grade, attending Hurst Hills Elementary, in Hurst. The investigation revealed that the enrollment was supported by counterfeit documents presented to the school.

The Detectives are concerned and preliminary information is that there may be additional child victims in the North Texas region. If citizens have had contact with the above individuals and are concerned about their child, please contact Hurst Police at 817-788-7146.

This case is still developing and actively being investigated.
