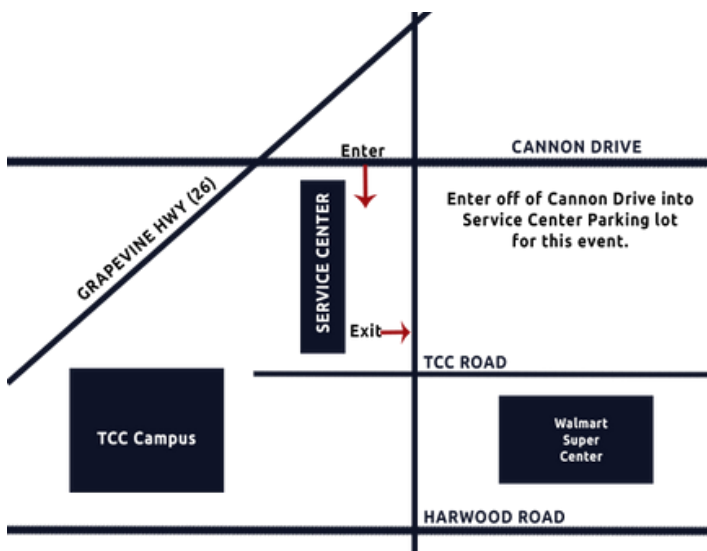


HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENT

Bring your household hazardous waste to the Service Center (2001 Precinct Line Road) on **January 10, 2026**, from 8–11 a.m., along with an ID and Hurst water bill. For a list of accepted items, visit hursttx.gov/calendar.

Document shredding will be available. Three box limit, no larger than 15" x 12" x 10" accepted. First come, first served, due to limited space. 6 Stones will be on-site accepting clothing donations from Hurst residents.

Proper disposal of household hazardous waste and other potential surface water pollutants is a concern to all. CEASE THE GREASE

This holiday season, we're making it easier than ever to Cease the Grease! The City of Hurst encourages residents to collect and recycle or safely dispose of all used fats, oils, and grease. When these items are washed down the drain, it sticks inside pipes. This hardening eventually leads to build-up that clogs and damages the sanitary sewer system.

WINTER WEATHER PREPAREDNESS

With winter weather approaching, we're sharing a few preparedness reminders to help you stay safe and ready before cold conditions arrive. Follow key tips such as never using ovens or gas stovetops for heat, keeping faucets dripping, checking smoke and carbon monoxide alarms, clearing snow and ice from meters and vents, and protecting pipes. Remember the 4 P's—check on **people** who may be vulnerable to the cold, bring **pets** indoors, insulate **pipes** and open cabinets to warm them, and cover **plants**. Stay safe this winter season!

NEW YEAR'S HOLIDAY CLOSURE

Non-emergency city facilities are closed on **Thursday, January 1, 2026**, in observance of the New Year's holiday. Trash and recycling service normally provided on Monday will be on regular schedule; Thursday will shift to Friday. Service normally provided on Tuesday will be on regular schedule; Friday will shift to Saturday. Emergency services will operate as normal.

The Community Services Department has specialty hours on Wednesday, December 31, 2025. The Hurst Recreation Center closes early at 5 p.m. The Hurst Tennis & Pickleball Center closes early at 1 p.m.

CITY FACILITIES DELAYED OPENING

Non-emergency city facilities will have a delayed opening until 2 p.m. on **Wednesday, January 14, 2026** for staff development training. Emergency services will operate as normal.

MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. DAY CLOSURE INFORMATION

Non-emergency city facilities will be closed in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day on **Monday, January 19, 2026**. The Hurst Recreation Center and Hurst Tennis & Pickleball Center will be open normal operating hours. Trash and recycling service is unaffected by this holiday and service normally provided Monday through Friday will be on regular schedule.
