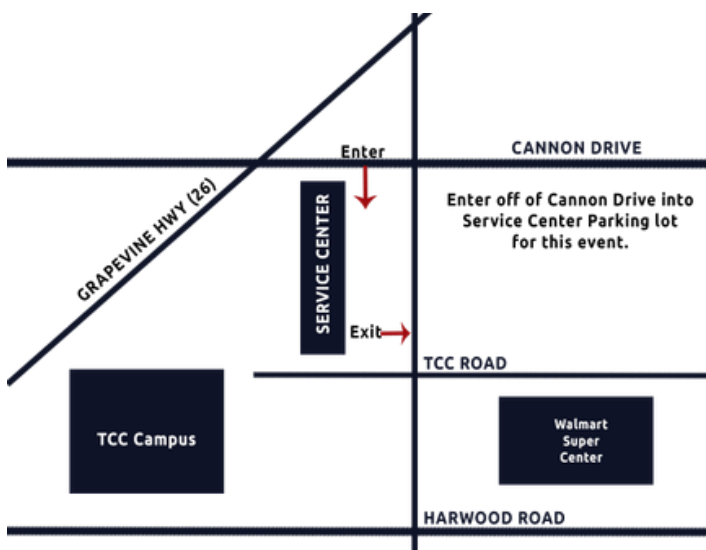


HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENT

Bring your household hazardous waste to the Service Center (2001 Precinct Line Road) on April 11, 2026, from 8–11 a.m., along with an ID and Hurst water bill. For a list of accepted items, visit hursttx.gov/calendar.

Document shredding will be available. Three box limit, no larger than 15" x 12" x 10" accepted. First come, first served, due to limited space. 6 Stones will be on-site accepting clothing donations from Hurst residents.

Proper disposal of household hazardous waste and other potential surface water pollutants is a concern to all. Should you become aware of any improper disposal of any stormwater or surface water pollutant, call the City's hotline at 817-788-7212. EXTRA BULK COLLECTION

We have partnered with Republic Services to provide residents with Extra Bulk Collection Days on **Saturday, April 4 (for residents with Monday & Thursday garbage service) and Saturday, April 11 (for residents with Tuesday & Friday garbage service)**. You can leave your bulky or green waste items at your curb; just make sure that loose items are bundled or containerized. Place your items for pickup by 7 a.m.

Accepted items: Any non-hazardous bulky items such as scrap metal, containerized brush, old fencing material or other debris (no commercial), electronic equipment including computers, TVs, DVD players, and cell phones

NOT accepted items: Tires & explosives, construction materials such as shingles and sheetrock, no more than six fence panels will be accepted unless a fence permit is shown for the address, compressed gas, pharmaceuticals, or sharps

FREE LANDFILL DAY - APRIL 11

The City of Hurst contracts with Republic Services to allow Hurst residents free access to the **Arlington Landfill (800 Mosier Valley Rd.)** on the second Saturday of each month through November from 7:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Residents must present their current drivers license or photo identification AND current Hurst water bill. FLOOD PREPAREDNESS

With severe weather season on its way, now is the time to prepare to keep you and your family protected. Here are a few reminders:

Know your flood risk:

Check your area's flood maps at fema.gov/flood-maps.

Get flood insurance:

It takes 30 days for a flood policy to go into effect, and homeowner's insurance doesn't cover floods! Visit floodsmart.gov or contact your insurance agent today.

Build your disaster supply kit:

Stock up on essentials like food, water, medical supplies, flashlights, batteries, and a NOAA Weather Radio. Learn more at ready.gov.

Protect your property:

Consider upgrades like waterproof veneers or raised electrical systems. Check fema.gov for retrofit ideas, and contact City of Hurst Community Development to gain applicable permits before starting any work.

Keep our waterways clean:

Remember, only rain goes down the drain! Prevent illegal dumping with the Don't Mess with Texas Water Program and help reduce flood risks.
