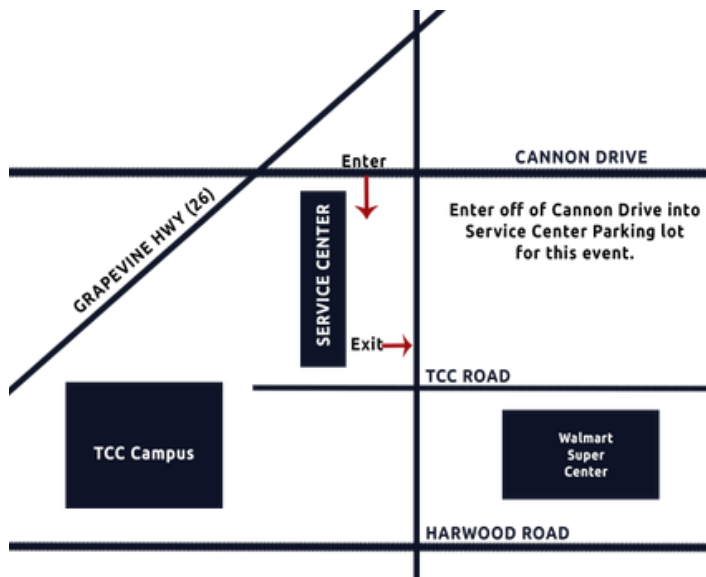


## HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION - JULY 11

Bring your household hazardous waste to the Service Center (2001 Precinct Line Rd.) on **July 11 from 8 - 11 a.m.** along with an ID and Hurst water bill. For a list of items accepted, visit [hursttx.gov/hhw](http://hursttx.gov/hhw).

Document shredding will be available. Three box limit, no larger than 15" x 12" x 10" accepted. Limited space. First come, first served. 6 Stones will be on-site accepting clothing donations from Hurst residents.
