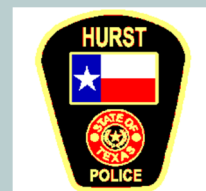

Topic: Attempted Kidnapping

On Thursday, November 7, 2013, around 4:10pm to 4:15pm, a 12 year-old female child was walking home from the bus stop at Hurstview Dr. / Springhill Dr. when a Hispanic male, driving a black SUV with a truck bed, followed her home. On Friday, November 8, 2013, the same child arrived at the bus stop around 4:10pm to 4:15pm, and the same Hispanic male appeared to be waiting for her. The male got out of his vehicle and chased the child. When the child got near her house, the male ran back to his vehicle.

Suspect Description: White or Hispanic Male, 40-50 yoa, 5'04" - 5'06", 160 - 180 lbs, clean shaven, shaved head on the sides, black clothing.

Suspect Vehicle: Black SUV with a truck bed, possibly a Chevrolet Avalanche or Cadillac Escalade.

North Richland Hills Police Department had a similar case on October 31, 2013. An 8 year old female child reported a white male opened the passenger door of his black SUV and tried to get the child in his vehicle. The black SUV or minivan was last seen traveling in the 9200 block of Meandering Way.

Suspect Description: White or Hispanic Male, 20-30 yoa, short light-brown hair, clean shaven.

Suspect Vehicle: Black SUV or minivan.
