Topic: Stolen Macaw-Captain Jack Found

As earlier reported in the local news, a macaw bird known as "Captain Jack" was stolen from an Arlington business on November 15<sup>th</sup>. Captain Jack has been found and was in the care of the Hurst Animal Services. Captain Jack will be reunited with his owner, tomorrow at 1000 AM, at the Hurst Animal Services building, located at 891 Cannon Drive (just west of Precinct Line Road), Hurst, TX

On November 17, at approximately 1:00 PM, Hurst Animal Services responded to a call in the 200 blk of Arcadia Street, where a witness reported an unknown SUV type vehicle had just abandoned a macaw bird onto the street. Animal Services recovered the bird and took the bird to the shelter. There were no known reports of this bird being stolen or lost.

Today, we were alerted that the macaw we had in custody was possibly Captain Jack, reported in the Star Telegram, as being stolen during a business burglary in Arlington. We have contacted the Arlington Police in regard to their investigation and the Arlington Police have approved the release of Captain Jack back to his owners. Captain Jack has been thriving under the loving care of an area veterinarian.
