Topic: Armed Robberies

On Tuesday, April 12, 2016, at approximately 7 a.m., Hurst Police Department officers responded to an armed robbery that just occurred at the Smile Donut Shop located at 604 E. Pipeline Road in Hurst. The victim said the two suspects had eaten at the shop this morning at around 5:30 a.m., and then returned around 7 a.m. and pointed a gun at the clerk. The two suspects stole money and fled on foot. There were no injuries.

Around 7:30 a.m., Hurst Police Department officers received a second armed robbery call. The suspect approached the victim in the Wellesley Park Apartments, pointed a gun at the victim, and demanded property. When the suspect fled on foot, the victim followed and called 911. The victim was not injured. The suspect went into an apartment in the complex. Upon arrival, officers surrounded the apartment. The Northeast Tarrant County Area Swat Team responded and searched the apartment and found it empty.

The two robberies appear to have been committed by the same suspects.

One of the suspects involved in the Smile Donut Shop was arrested nearby. His identity is not being released at this time due to the ongoing investigation. The second suspect remains at large.
