Topic: Suspicious Person

The Hurst Police Department is looking into a suspicious incident that occurred yesterday (Tuesday, September 19th) at approximately 3:15 pm in the 100 block of Plaza Blvd. in Hurst near the Harrison Lane Elementary School. A nine year old female student reported that the driver of a black van was driving slowly down the street and was watching her as she was walking home. The driver stopped his vehicle a few feet away from her and exited the van and walked towards her, at which point she ran away to her house and reported the incident to her family. The driver did not say anything to the child or make any other overt acts. The van's driver was described as a thinly built hispanic male with short hair and a mustache. The van was further described as being very dirty with no windows on the sides or back (panel van) with light blue colored hubcaps on the wheels. No criminal offense is being investigated at this time, but due to the young age of the child and the close proximity to the elementary school, the Hurst Police Department is asking that anyone who might have witnessed this incident or has further information to contact us as soon as possible in case there have been other similar unreported incidents.
